AKC Trick Dog and Stunt Dog Teaching, Training & Evaluations for Titles at Camp Haven Kennels

(7 week program, 6 weeks of training with testing on the 7th week).

Why teach tricks? Not just because they are fun! They help you teach your dog to think and solve problems with you as a team.

Training tricks also:

1. Helps you perfect your timing.
2. Trick handling improves your skills as a handler. As you both work together you become a better teacher and your dog a better student. It is about spending time together in a fun and enjoyable manner.
3. Trick training is valuable because it teaches your dog how to learn. As their ability to learn develops, they quickly acquire new skills.
4. Trick training builds confidence in fearful and anxious dogs.
5. Tricks are a great way for reactive dogs to spend time with their handlers having fun and avoiding anxieties and stress.
6. Tricks helps build a solid relationship with you and your dog. Your dog will love learning and working with you.
7. Trick training helps dogs build confidence. In teaching tricks there are no wrong answers and your dog is always right.

From the 1920's through the 1950's trick dogs such as Lassie and Rin Tin Tin entertained the hearts of people worldwide. Trick dog training has become one of the most exciting new areas in dog training. All dogs can get a title, including purebreds and mixed breeds and are registered through the AKC in either their mixed breed program (Canine Partners) or purebred (AKC or PAL). In this class you will train for two of AKC's newest trick dog titles:

AKC Novice Trick Dog Title and AKC Intermediate Trick Dog Title.

Class Requirements:

Completion of a basic obedience/manners class and/or puppy class is desired but not necessary.

Up to date on vaccinations.

No known aggression towards people or dogs.

Your registration fee includes a 6-week group training class.

On the 7th week you will have the opportunity to test for AKC Trick Dog Titles.

Fee for the Trick Dog Evaluation is \$10.00 per test title evaluated.
